Volunteer Job Description Budgeting Coach

Nature of Work:

A volunteer budgeting coach participates in the Freedom in Your Finance (FIYF) I or II course at Baxter Community Center. The individual will be paired with an individual/family seeking knowledge and understanding about how to manage personal finances.

Course Information:

- Freedom in Your Finance I (FIYF) is a faith-based approach for families to develop skills needed to manage personal finances.
 - It is a 14-week course commitment.
 - Interested coaches will attend a short training session one week followed by a 13-week course.
 - Coaches need to be available throughout the 13-week course and attend weekly classes.
 - Classes are on Thursday evenings from 6 – 8 p.m.
 - FIYF I will run from February 18 – May 27, 2010.
 - Books and other learning tools are provided.
 - Light snacks are provided.
 - Child care is provided.
- FIYF II
 - It is a 8-week course commitment.
 - Interested coaches will attend a short training session one week followed by a 7-week course.
 - Coaches need to be available throughout duration of the course.
 - Classes are on independent from FIYF I.
 - Light snacks are provided.
 - Child care is provided.
